



## **SELMA-KINGSBURG-FOWLER COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT**

**CLASSIFICATION:** Sewerage System Maintenance Technician I

**DATE POSTED:** May 15, 2026

**SUMMARY:** Under the close and direct supervision of the Assistant Collections Supervisor, performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in the cleaning, maintenance, inspection, and repair of the District's wastewater collection system, both on regular and stand-by duty.

**SALARY:** \$4,248 – \$5,422 per month (Range 12 "A" step through "Y" step)

\* A 3% base wage increase will be effective first pay period after July 1, 2026. Up to 9% wage rate increase for additional certification pay.

**REGULAR WORK HOURS:** Daylight Saving Time: 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. End of Daylight-Saving Time: 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Must be able to work standby, overtime, weekends, evenings and holidays.

**REQUIREMENTS:** One or more years of experience in maintenance and construction, preferably as a plumber, pipe layer, equipment operator, or collection system maintenance worker.

Education equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade. College level course work or trade school training in wastewater collection, mechanical repair, wastewater treatment technology, or a related field is highly desirable.

Possession of a valid California Class C driver's license at time of appointment and ability to obtain and maintain an unrestricted Class B driver's license with tank and air brake endorsements within the first six months of employment. Possession and maintenance of a Grade I Collections System Maintenance Certification issued by the California Water Environment Association Technical Certification Program within two years of hire date.

Must be able to report to worksite within 45 minutes after receiving notification of being called back.

**BENEFITS:** Twelve paid holidays per year. Paid vacation (increases with length of service). One day per month accrued for paid sick leave. Health, dental and vision insurance partial paid by District for employee and dependent. Life insurance for employees paid by District. CalPERS 2% at 62 retirement system instead of Federal Social Security.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The District is an equal opportunity employer. Selection will be based on an appraisal of the applicant's preparation for employment as presented in the completed Application for Employment and on the results of a written and/or oral and/or performance examination. The examination will cover the applicant's ability to perform the duties and fulfill the requirements of the classification, as listed in the Job Description. A pre-employment background investigation will be conducted by a licensed private investigator selected by the District. A physical examination must be successfully completed as a condition of any employment offer which may be made by the District. The physician is selected and paid by the District. The examination includes a drug screening test. A positive test will result in disqualification from employment consideration.
