

## SELMA-KINGSBURG-FOWLER COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT

**CLASSIFICATION**: Assistant Plant Operations Supervisor

<u>SUMMARY</u>: Under general direction of the Plant Operations Manager, oversees the day-to-day operations of the operations and maintenance department of the wastewater treatment plant facilities in order for the District to comply with local, state, federal and District codes and regulations.

<u>SALARY</u>: \$6,922.41 - 8,834.94 per month (Range 875 "A" step through "Y" step)

4% salary increase effective July 1, 2024

\*Up to 7.5% wage rate increase for additional certification pay

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: Possess and maintain a valid California Class C driver's license at time of appointment. Possess and maintain a valid Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Grade III Certificate issued by the State Water Resources Control Board at the time of appointment. Possess and maintain a valid Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Grade IV Certificate issued by the State Water Resources Control Board within 24 months of hire date. Minimum of four years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater treatment plant facility as a Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Grade III. Two years in a position of leadership and responsibility is desirable.

<u>EDUCATION</u>: Equivalent to completion of twelfth grade and college level course work in the treatment of wastewater.

<u>BENEFITS</u>: Twelve paid holidays per year. Paid vacation (increases with length of service). One day per month accrued for paid sick leave. Health, dental and vision insurance partial paid by District for employee only; dependent coverage available paid by employee. Life insurance for employee paid by District. CalPERS 2% at 62 retirement system instead of Federal Social Security. Employees hired after February 9, 2012, will pay 100% of the employee contribution/share required to participate in CalPERS.

training. Therefore, applicants are urged to submit sufficiently detailed information in their application and supplemental application for evaluation. A pre-employment background investigation will be conducted by a licensed private investigator selected by the District.
