DISTRICT ENGINEER

SERVICES & OBJECTIVES

The District is located in Fresno County. The District collects, treats and disposes of wastewater originating from the residential, commercial, institutional and industrial dischargers from the three member cities and parts of unincorporated Fresno County. The District operates and maintains the wastewater treatment plant and the sewer collection system. The District refurbishes and replaces each city's facilities. The member cities own the local sewer collection system, which includes sewers, lift stations, and appurtenances not owned by the District. Each member city is responsible for expanding the facilities that it owns. The District serves an estimated population of over 44,000.

LOCATION

The wastewater treatment and disposal facilities are located on a 550 acre site 1.5 miles west of Kingsburg, CA.

THE POSITION

The District Engineer plays a pivotal role in the overseeing and management for the day-to-day operations of the Engineering Department; manages the District's Capital Improvement Program, Collections System Master Plan, and various engineering and asset management projects and programs from evaluation through design and construction. The incumbent supervises the Engineering Technicians. Incumbent coordinates activities with other District officials, departments, outside agencies, organizations, and the public.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- A Bachelor's degree in Civil, Mechanical, Environmental, or Sanitary Engineering or closely related field
- Registration as a Professional Engineer in the State of California is required
- A minimum of five years of professional level engineering experience in a water, wastewater, or public works related setting, including two years of supervisory experience. Experience in a public setting is desirable
- Valid California Class C driver's license at the time of appointment

COMPENSATION & BENEFITS

The approved salary range for the District Engineer is **\$107,891- \$137,699** per year based on qualifications and experience. Effective July 28, 2025 the approved salary range is **\$112,207—\$143,207** per year, and is eligible for up to 9% wage rate increase for additional certification pay.

Benefits include:

- California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS 2%@55 years for classic members without a six month gap in service or 2%@62 years for new members as defined under PEPRAs); SKF does not participate in Social Security;
- Twelve paid holidays per year; Two Floating Holidays; One Personal Business Day; Vacation: 10 days per year maxing out to 20 days per year, based on years of service; One day per month accrued for paid sick leave;
- Health insurance partial paid by District for employee and dependents. Dental and vision insurance coverage by employer;
- Option to participate in a Deferred Compensation (pre-tax) 457 Plan
